



## Wellness and Safety and FAQ's: Oneway and Junction

Oneway is designed for kindergarten through 4th graders. Your kids will find a highly interactive environment with great worship, creative teaching, and small groups which will help them grow in their relationship with God. Junction 567 addresses the specific needs of 5th through 7th graders. Junction is a unique mix of children's ministry and youth ministry. Junction serves as a powerful tool to connect kids to God and each other as well as prepare them for Generation Church. For the safety and well-being of your child and all of our kiddo's in Uptown please adhere to the policies and procedures that are outlined.

### ALERTS AND REQUEST

If your child has any allergies or any other special needs or conditions, please inform the Uptown volunteer at the checkin booth. Also, upon dropping your child off please inform one of the volunteers in your child's worship environment.

We welcome parents of children new to Uptown in our Oneway and Junction 567 environments to spend a few weeks to acclimate their child to the class. Once your child feels comfortable, we encourage you to leave your child so that you can enjoy the service.

To cut down on confusion and crowding in the classroom and hall, we request that you drop off your child at the door instead of entering the classroom.

In order to cut down on crowds in the childcare area, we would encourage only one parent to drop off or pick up your child.

We ask that on your way into Uptown your kids take advantage of our kid only restrooms.

## ITEMS YOU BRING

Because personal toys, dolls, etc. can be lost or cause other children to become upset, we would recommend that you leave toys, dolls, etc. at home.

## TAGS

To keep our kids safe we ask that every parent have your parent tag to enter Uptown and specifically the Oneway and Junction 567 environments.

This is a security measure so that people who are not authorized do not come into the rooms and play with or hold children.

The parent tags are required to pick up your child. Our Uptown volunteers cannot release children without a parent tag or the authorization of Uptown Leadership Staff member (Pastor Josh or Rachel or Uptown Leadership Staff)

## PAGING

If for whatever reason your child needs you during the service, we will page you via Google txt. Upon checking your child in please make sure we have a current cell phone number. Make sure to turn your cell phone to vibrate so that you can be reached without disturbing the service.

## GUEST VISITING UPTOWN FOR THE FIRST TIME

If you are visiting with us for the first time, please visit our checkin station at the entrance of Uptown. After filling out the registration form you will be issued 2 different tags. One is for your child that has their name, specific environment, any known allergies, cell phone for paging, and an alpha-numeric symbol that is unique to you and your child. This symbol changes each week.

For your child's tag we suggest that you place that on their back where they are unable to reach it.

For your tag we ask that you have it in a visible area. This will be needed so you can enter Uptown.

## MEDICATIONS

For any child with severe allergies requiring an EpiPen, please be sure to supply this to one of the Uptown Leadership Team.

We are unable to administer any other medication to your child. If your child requires medication, please make arrangements so that you can personally administer what is required.

## INJURIES AND FIRST AID

We can administer ONLY Band-Aids and ice packs.

If there is an injury in Oneway or Junction 567, the assigned Uptown volunteer will notify the supervisor and you, the parent. Together we will fill out an Ouch Report.

## WELLNESS

Children must be symptom free from the following illnesses without medication for 24 hours before entering Uptown:

- Fever of 100 degrees or higher
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye or other eye infection)
- Rash
- Nasal drainage which is green or yellow
- Sore throat
- Open sores
- Cold
- Excessive coughing
- Lice

Please note: We do not recognize teething as being a cause of fever or diarrhea.

If your child develops any of these symptoms while in class you will be paged.

## THE CANDY SHOP, FUN PASS, AND POINTS

To make the checkin process easier at our weekend service you can ask our checkin volunteers to set up a Fun Pass Card so you can take advantage of our self checkin booth. This card can be connected to your whole family and be used to checkin to multiple environments in Uptown.

If you have multiple children with Fun Pass Cards, only the first card you were issued can be used for checkin. Your other children's cards can only be received at the Uptown Candy Shop and will only be active for the Uptown Candy Shop.

The Fun Pass Card can also be used to earn points at our Uptown Candy Shop for those students in Oneway and Junction 567.

For your child to receive the points that they have earned for attendance, they must checkin at the Uptown Candy Shop or sign in at the podium near the shop.

- Saturday evening 5 pm service points earned: 300
- Sunday morning 9 am service points earned: 300
- Sunday morning 11 am service points earned: 100

In addition to earning points for attending, your child can earn points for memorizing our monthly scripture verse and completing our monthly God Time Card by the end of each month.

The scripture verse can be told to their small group leader and they will receive 100 additional points.

God Time Cards has will be given at the beginning of each month. There is a place to initial each week that you accomplished this devotional together. At the end of the month they can bring this card in with 4 initials and receive an additional 200 points.
